June 5, 1992 Allen Parrott resigns from a term that had already expired to take a church in Charleston, leaving council with 6 members. Benard Haire and Dr. W. Everette Salley continue to serve until an election is held even though their term expired in September 1991.

1991-1995 Election was not held due to NAACP legal action putting off the election until redistricting could be done as per the 1990 census. Then all council seats would be elected.

1992 The Justice Department approves a redistricting plan and the election is set for March 1993 at which time districts 2, 4, & 6 will be elected to a term ending Sept 1995. Districts 1, 3, & 5 will be elected to a term ending Sept. 1993. In Sept. 1993 election will be held for the office of mayor and councilmen from districts 1, 3, & 5. One person from each district was qualified to run for office on 9 March 1993.
