Bon Fire Application

The SC Fire Code section 3074.1 states: A bonfire shall not be conducted within 50 feet of a structure or combustible material unless the fire is contained in a barbecue pit. Conditions that could cause a fire to spread within 50 feet of a structure shall be eliminated prior to ignition.

1. Bonfires shall not be ignited with accelerants. (i.e. gasoline, kerosene)
2. Bonfires shall contain only natural products. Trash, plastics, tires, household debris is prohibited.
3. Responsible person shall remain with the bonfire during the entirety of the event and be available for contact by the fire department.
4. A site survey shall be completed prior to the start of the event by the fire department.
5. At least one portable fire extinguisher of with a minimum size of 4-A shall be in attendance if a fire truck is unable to attend.
6. Burning is not allowed if wind speeds are greater than 10 mph.
7. Burning is not allowed if a burn ban or red flag warning is in effect issued by the SC Forestry Commission. <https://www.state.sc.us/forest/>
