ORDINANCE NO. 2020 - 11

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE EXTENDING EMERGENCY ORDINANCES NUMBERS 2020-03, 2020-04 AND 2020-05 DATED JUNE 4, 2020, JUNE 30, 2020 AND JULY 27, 2020

WHEREAS, South Carolina Code of Laws Section 5-7-250 (d) authorizes the adoption of emergency ordinances with immediate effectiveness, and

WHEREAS, by Mayoral Proclamation dated April 8, 2020 a State of Emergency was declared because of circumstances and conditions which continue to exist, and a Curfew was ordered and established in the City of Orangeburg; and,

WHEREAS, the Proclamation included the establishment, membership and authority of a Committee of Disaster Services, the authority to hold remote Council meetings and home delivery regulations; and,

WHEREAS, said Proclamation was extended and ratified by Emergency Ordinances of City Council dated April 16, 2020 and June 4, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Curfew and its enforcement were rescinded by Proclamation dated May 19, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, Council wishes to extend the remaining provisions of the Mayoral Proclamation of April 8, 2020, and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance dated June 30, 2020 Council adopted an Emergency Ordinance requiring face coverings in retail and foodservice establishments and other matters related thereto; and,

WHEREAS, by Ordinance Number 2020-05 dated July 27, 2020 Emergency Ordinances Numbers 2020-03 and 2020-04 dated June 4, 2020 and June 30, 2020 were extended for an additional sixty-one (61) days beginning on July 27, 2020 with an expiration date of September 25, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, Council wishes to extend the expiration date of the above Ordinances for an additional sixty-one (61) days.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by a two-third (2/3) affirmative vote of the Mayor and Council of the City of Orangeburg, this 15th day of September, 2020, that the Mayoral Proclamation dated April 8, 2020, as amended by Mayoral Proclamation dated May 19, 2020, and Emergency Ordinances Numbers 2020-03, 2020-04 and 2020-05 dated June 4, 2020, June 30, 2020 and July 27, 2020 are extended for an additional sixty-one (61) days beginning upon adoption of this Ordinance.
