



ORDINANCE No. 2024-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF ORANGEBURG DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES OPERATING BUDGET ORDINANCE NO. 2023-15 FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2024 (DPU PROJECT HOUSE 2)

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGEBURG ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The estimated costs associated with the referenced project for the City's natural gas system are expected to be \$900,000. This project will be designated as a Special Project for a period not to exceed 15 years. The City Council authorizes and appropriates these additional funds as an additional cost of the Department of Public Utilities planned project and amends the annual capital improvement plan accordingly.

SECTION 2. In all other respects, except as provided in this Ordinance, the budget for the city related to the Department of Public Utilities for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2024, remains in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, resolutions, orders, or other administrative actions in conflict with this Ordinance, only to the extent of that conflict, are repealed.

- I. Purpose – The purpose of this project is to extend natural gas service to a new area of the county.
- II. Rationale – This part of the county presently does not have natural gas service. Project House 2 is projected to have new development in the next year. Development of this type were expected when natural gas service was extended to the town of Ellore. This project to be designated as a Special Project for a period of 15 years.
- III. Plan - The project will require construction of approximately 17,000 feet of 8-inch gas main and 6,000 feet of 6-inch gas main.
