## ORDINANCE NO. 2020-02

## AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE EXTENDING AND RATIFYING MAYORAL **PROCLAMATION OF APRIL 8, 2020**

South Carolina Code of Laws Section 5-7-250 (d) authorizes the adoption of WHEREAS,

emergency ordinances with immediate effectiveness, and

WHEREAS, by Mayoral Proclamation dated April 8, 2020 a State of Emergency was

declared and a Curfew was ordered and established in the City of Orangeburg; and,

WHEREAS, the Proclamation included the establishment, membership and authority of a

Committee of Disaster Services, the authority to hold remote Council meetings

and home delivery regulations; and,

WHEREAS, the Proclamation and all of the above expires on April 22, 2020 and City

Council desires to now extend the said Proclamation in its entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by a two-third (2/3) affirmative vote of the Mayor and Council of the City of Orangeburg, South Carolina, this 16th day of April, 2020, that the Mayoral Proclamation dated April 8, 2020 is ratified and extended, including the establishment, membership and authority of the Committee of Disaster Services, authority to hold remote council meetings, the declaration of curfew and its enforcement and adoption of home delivery regulations.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Proclamation extension and this Ordinance is effective as of April 16, 2020 and both will expire on June 15, 2020, the sixty-first day after the Ordinance adoption, unless sooner terminated by the Mayor as authorized hereinbelow.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Mayor is hereby granted the authority to terminate the extended Proclamation of April 8, 2020 in its entirety or by section by subsequent Proclamation.
