AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF ORANGEBURG, SOUTH CAROLINA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 1998 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 1999

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGEBURG HEREBY ORDAINS AND RATIFIES:

Section 1. That the Budget of the City of Orangeburg for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 1998 and ending September 30, 1999, designated as Ordinance No. 1998-13 shall be and hereby is amended so to levy a tax to cover the period from the first day of January 1998, to the thirty-first day of December 1998, both inclusive, for the sums and in the manner hereinafter mentioned and shall be levied, collected and paid into the Treasury of the City of Orangeburg, South Carolina for the use and service thereof, i.e., a tax of seventy-two (72) mills and the same is hereby assessed on each dollar of the assessed value of all real estate and personal property within the City of Orangeburg, South Carolina, except as such which is exempt from taxation by law.

Section 2. That in all other respects, except as hereby and heretofore amended, the budget for the City of Orangeburg for the Fiscal Year beginning October I, 1998, and ending September 30, 1999, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCES NO. 1998-7 AND 1998-15 ENACTED MAY 4, 1998 AND SEPTEMBER 15, 1998, RESPECTIVELY, REQUIRING FRANCHISE OR CONSENT AGREEMENT FOR PLACING LINES IN STREETS AND LEVYING A BUSINESS LICENSE TAX ON COMMUNICATIONS ACTIVITIES

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Orangeburg, State of South Carolina adopted Ordinance No. 1998-7 on May 5, 1998 and Ordinance No. 1998-15 on September 15, 1998 imposing a license tax in the amount of 5% on gross receipts of establishments providing local or long distance telephone communications, and

WHEREAS, the City deems it advisable to amend said ordinance by reducing the business license rate from 5% to 3% and providing for the application of a credit for any business license tax paid against any franchise fee,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Orangeburg, State of South Carolina in Council duly assembled that Ordinance No. 1998-15 is here by amended and after amendment shall read as follows:

Section 1. Permission to use streets required

It shall be unlawful for any person to construct, install, maintain or operate in, on, above or under any street or public place under control of the municipality any line, pipe, cable, pole, structure or facility for utilities, communications, cablevision or other purposes without a consent agreement or franchise agreement issued by the municipal council by ordinance which prescribes the term, fees and conditions for use.

Section 2. Consent or franchise fee.

The annual fee for use of streets or public places authorized by a consent agreement or franchise agreement shall be set by the ordinance approving the agreement and shall be based on gross revenues derived from activities in the municipality, the length of lines installed in streets and public places, or other formula deemed appropriate by council. No consent fee or franchise fee shall be construed to be in lieu of a business license tax based on gross revenue unless specifically provided by ordinance. A credit for all business license taxes paid under this ordinance shall be applied to franchise fees set by ordinance, unless specifically provided otherwise by the franchise ordinance, and to all franchise fees required by existing franchise ordinances.

Section 3. Business license tax on telephone communications.

Establishments providing local or long distance telephone communications as described in Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) group 481, including voice and data communications; radiotelephone services; cellular telephone services; paging and beeper services; leasing lines, fiber optic cables, microwave or satellite facilities; selling access and reselling use of facilities or methods to others shall pay an annual business license tax of 3% of gross receipts from all communications activities conducted in the municipality and for communications services billed to customers located in the municipality on which a business license tax has not been paid to another municipality.

Be it further ordained that the Business License Schedule, Category 980000- Telecommunications Services, is amended by reducing the business license rate prescribed therein from 5% to 3%.

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCING OF REAL PROPERTY IMPROVEMENTS AND THE LEASE OF PROPERTIES TO BRANCH BANKING AND TRUST COMPANY

- 2. All financing contracts and all related documents for the closing of the financing (the "Financing Documents") shall be consistent with the foregoing terms. The City Administrator of the City is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver any Financing Documents, and to take all such further action as he may consider necessary or desirable, to carry out the financing of the Project as contemplated by the proposal and this ordinance. The Financing Documents shall include a Base Lease, a Lease Agreement and an Escrow Agreement as BB&T may request. The City Administrator on behalf of the City is hereby authorized to execute and deliver said Lease Agreements, including the Base Lease which leases to BB&T the properties described on Exhibit A of said Base Lease in accordance with its terms, and conditions. (A copy of said Base Lease being attached hereto as Exhibit B.)
- 3. The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to hold executed copies of the Financing Documents until the conditions for the delivery of the Financing Documents have been completed to such officer's satisfaction. The City Administrator is authorized to approve changes to any Financing Documents previously signed by the City Administrator, provided that such changes shall not substantially alter the intent of such documents or certificates from the intent expressed in the forms executed by such officer. The Financing Documents shall be in such final forms as the City Administrator shall approve, with the City Administrator's release of any Financing Document for delivery constituting conclusive evidence of such officer's final approval of the Document's final form.
- 4. The City shall not take or omit to take any action the taking or omission of which will cause its interest payments on this financing to be includable in the gross income for federal income tax purposes of the registered owners of the interest payment obligations. The City hereby designates its obligations to make principal and interest payments under the Financing Documents as "qualified tax exempt obligations" for the purpose of Internal Revenue Code Section 265(b)(3).
- 5. All prior actions of City officers in furtherance of the purposes of this ordinance are hereby ratified, approved and confirmed. AN ORDINANCE TO RAISE REVENUE AND ADOPT A BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF ORANGEBURG, SOUTH CAROLINA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 1999, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2000.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council Members of the City of Orangeburg, South Carolina, in Council assembled, and by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. In accordance with Section 5-7-260 of the 1976 Code of Laws of South Carolina, and Council shall act by Ordinance to adopt budgets, levy taxes, and collect all other income sources available to the City pursuant to public notice.

SECTION 2. That the prepared budget for the fiscal year October 1, 1999--September 30, 2000, and the estimated revenue for payment of same is hereby adopted.

SECTION 3. That a tax to cover the period from the first day of January, 1999 to the Thirty-first day of December, 1999, both inclusive, for the sums and in the manner hereinafter mentioned, is and shall be levied, collected and paid into the treasury of the City of Orangeburg for the use and service thereof, i.e., a tax of 72-mills be and the same is hereby assessed on each dollar of the assessed value of all real estate and personal property within the City of Orangeburg, South Carolina, except as such which is exempt from taxation by law.

SECTION 4. Tax levied under this Ordinance shall be due and payable at the office of the City Clerk and Treasurer, in the Municipal building of the City of Orangeburg, South Carolina, from the first day of November, 1999, until the fifteenth day of January 2000, from the hours of 8:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M., Monday through Friday, Saturdays and Sundays excepted.

SECTION 5. On January 16, 2000, a penalty of fifteen (15) percent shall be added on all unpaid taxes. The City Clerk and Treasurer shall on March 17, 2000, place all delinquent properties in execution by Section 24-11, as amended, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Orangeburg, South Carolina.

SECTION 6. If for any reason, any sentence, clause of provisions of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid, such shall not affect the remaining provisions thereof.
